Subject: Amendment of Pan India Auction Rules on Divisibility of lot for South India

Sir/Madam,

This has reference to the Pan India Auction Rules notified by Tea Board vide circular Ref. No. 6(29)/LC/Gen/2011-13/P-I dated 06.05.2016 and subsequent Order issued by the Board vide Ref. No.Law/WP/66/2016 dated 02.08.2016 in relation to divisibility norms to be followed by the auction centres in South India.

In this regard, I am directed to inform that based on the representation received from Coonoor Tea Trade Association (CTTA) and various deliberations held with the stakeholders across South India, the rule No.44 of Pan India Auction Rules pertaining to division of lot for South India is now amended as per the attached Annexure. The revised division rule of lot size will be implemented from sale No 49/2021 of all the auction centres in South India, i.e., Coonoor, Coimbatore, Cochin and Teaserve.
