Each page to be stamped and signed by the Authorised signatory of

	III. Application fees of Rs. 3000/- to be paid in the form of Draft/RTGS as per bank details along with the application
How to renew Permission?	The Permission shall be valid for one year from the date of issue. The Application for renewal must be filed 15 (fifteen) days prior to expiry of the Agreement. For renewal the following documents needs to be sent to the following address: IPR Cell, Tea Board, 14, BTM Sarani, Kolkata-1 1. Renewal Fees of Rs.3000/- to be paid in the form of Draft/RTGS as per bank details. 2. Packets wherein the logo mark of 'Nilgiri' has been used.
Can the logo be used after expiry of the period stipulated in the agreement? Is it mandatory to use the logo as per the specification detailed in the agreement?	No. If logo is found to be used without authorization or after expiry of the period stipulated in the Agreement, the Board shall be at liberty to initiate penal action in addition to the cancelation of Registration/License issued under TMCO, 2003 and TDECO, 2005.
How many days it will take to get the permission?	About Five working days if all the documents are in order.
